Covid 19 Policies & Procedures

- Please meet your camp leader at the bottom of the stairs at the main entrance to Max Turyk for drop off and pick up.
- Staff may ask parents and caregivers about illness at drop-off to confirm that the child does not have symptoms of common cold, influenza, COVID-19, or other respiratory distress.
- Additional hand hygiene practices and opportunities will be worked into the daily schedule for staff and kiddos. Branch Out will follow the guidelines set by the Public Health Guidance for Childcare. (BCCDC.CA)
- Additional cleaning protocols are in place to sanitize high-use areas.
- Masks are mandatory within Max Turyk public areas (hallways) for staff and all individuals capable of putting on and taking off their own mask. Your adventure camp leader will have their mask on at all times.
- If anyone within the home has symptoms of COVID-19, please contact us and keep your child home.
- If a child develops symptoms during camp, the parent/guardian will be contacted for pick up.
- A Self-Assessment waiver is required
